## RUM RIVER BOYS TRACK HISTORY

According to records, Elk River's first track team was competing in 1939-40. There were a total of 2 lettermen on that team; D. Balheimer and J. Perry. For the 1941-42 season, Len Gans who is now the head coach of White Bear Lake Track, was a member of the team. He competed in the High Jump and the Long Jump.

By the end of the 1953-54 season, Elk River had 4 track letterman. In the 55-56 season, the track team was very powerful. They placed 2nd in the District 16 and were the Region IV Champions. Two of the outstanding performances turns in were by Leo A Gray and the 440 Relay team. Gray set a new school record in the 100 yard dash with a time of 10.3. The 380 Relay team of Lloyd Gray, Rollie Banks, Gene Sellien, and Paul Kueper placed first in the District 16 meet. The Elks had 14 letter winners in 1960-61. Of these lettermen, 5 were 9th graders and 1 was an 8th grader.

The 1965 track team advanced two entrants to the state meet. Walt Malmstrom qualified in the 680 yard run and placed 3rd. The Mile Relay team also qualified for the state meet. The team was made up of Carl Daffars, Walt Malmstrom, Dick Lens, and John MacIntyre. In the spring of 1966 Walt Malmstrom again qualified for the state track meet and again placed 3rd. His time of 1 minute 54 seconds is not only still an Elk River school record, but still stands as one of the best 600s ever run in Minnesota. Also qualifying for the State Meet was John MacIntyre in the Pole Vault. However, he broke his pole and could not compete.

In 1971 the Elks had a young team but they were very strong. The Elks won the St. Francis Invitational, the Centennial Relays and placed 2nd in the Rum River Conference. The Elks also had two entrants at the State Track meet. They were Frank Kepetka who placed 5th in the Long Jump with a leap of 21 ft 9 $\frac{1}{4}$  in., and Mike Lafebvre who qualified in the 100 yard dash. 23 letters were awarded in 1971.

Things really began to look good in the spring of 1972 as the Elks won the St. Francis Invitational, the Rosemount Invitational, the Princeton Invitational, the Rum River Conference and placed 2nd in the District 16 meet.

In 1973 the Elks again were the Rum River Champions. In addition they won the Rosemount Invitational, the Centennial Relays, the Syring Lake Park Panther Invitational, the Sub Region Class A meet and the runner up spot in the Region IV class A meet. This was the first year that the state track meet was split into classes and Elk River participated in the Class A meet with two state entrants. They were Jeff Hawkins who won the High Hurdles and placed 3rd in the low hurdles; and Steve Sait who qualified in the High Hurdles and Long Jump but could not compete because of bad hamstring pull. The 1973 team broke 12 school records.

The 1974 season was the best yet for the Elks. Team results were: Rum River Champions, Princeton Invitational Champions, St. Paul Park Class S Champions, Sub Region Class A Champions, Region IV A Class A Champions and State Class A runner-up. The Elks had 3 state entrants; Jeff Hawkins, Steve Sait and Dan Reents. Jeff won the High Hurdles in a time of 14.6, the Low Hurdles in 19.3 and made the finals of the 100 Yard dash. Steve placed second in the High Hurdles in a time of 14.3 and second in the Long Jump with a leap of 21 ft 9 $\frac{3}{4}$  inches. Dan Reents qualified in the Shot Put. The Elks broke 6 school records that year.

1975 was a year of surprises. The Elks turned out some of the best relay times in the state. Greg Shuza, Maryl Roy, Brian Klems and Steve Brant broke school records in the 2 Mile Relay (8:12) and the Mile Relay (3:26). Bruce Powers, Brian Klems, Maryl Roy and Greg Shuza broke the School Record in the Sprint Medley Relay with a time of 3:35.1. These are still school records. The Sprint Medley Relay team and the Mile Relay team both placed 4th in the State Meet. Steve Brant qualified for the finals of the 380 Yard run. For the 4th year in a row the Elks were the Rum River Champions and it was also the last year for the Elks to be in the Rum River Conference.

In 1976 the Elks found themselves in the Skyline Conference for the first time and the last time. There was no doubt that this was a tough conference. The Elks had one of their youngest teams and it proved to be a learning experience for most of the team. Only 7 seniors participated this year. Grant Hartman had a great year in the High Hurdles. Brad Grupa was selected as MVP, posted a time of 20.2 in the Low Hurdles was the Conference Champion in the Low Hurdles and placed in the Regions. By far the best performance of the year came from Paul Zabec. Not only did he break the school

record in the Discus, but he placed 2nd in the Regions and 3rd in the State Class AA meet with a toss of 159 ft 8 in. Lastly, this was also the year that Bill Winter, after 6 successful years as Head Track Coach, decided to hang up his stopwatch. Many thanks and memories go with him.

1977 was an interesting year, for several reasons; first of which was the fact that the Elks would not be in a conference. Second, the Elks had two new coaches; the Head Coaching position went to Rollie Jarvi while Colin Anderson one of the top ranked Shot Putters in the U.S. took over Shot and Discus duties for both the boys and girls. Finally, this was the year of the Soph. 11 Performance records were broken and 1 was tied. The experience from the junior high and the hard work during this season paid off. The Elks won the Centennial Invitational and came within a point of several other meets. One varsity record was broken. The 440 Relay team of Dan Zelles, Steve Slavik, Craig Hinrichs and Clint Leger clocked a time of 45.9. The Elks competing in one of the top Regions in the state, qualified several people for the finals, all who were underclassmen. The outlook for 1978 was promising.

1978 was a great year! If you look at the competition and schedule, you might have to say it was one of the Elks all-time great seasons. Not only was the Central Lakes Conference tough, but meets like the Burnsville Relays, Coon Rapids Invitational, and Region IV AA pitted the Elks against some of the states best. The Elks passed the test. Along the way 7 varsity records were broken, with the oldest Elk record in the Pole Vault being broken by Rob Lahnakos with a first place finish in the Central Lakes Conference and a 4th place finish in Region IV, the Elks proved they could run with the best. Senior Jeff Miller broke both the Elks 220 and 110 records, and qualified for the state meet in the 220. Rick Steblay broke the Intermediate Hurdle record and ran well enough in the High Hurdles to earn him a 5th place in the State Class AA meet. Many of the Elks set PRs (Personal Records) during the year and if you can measure success by how many people had PRs, the Elks had a very successful season. Many new goals will be waiting to challenge the Elks in 1979.

Injuries and success both dominated the 1979 season. Key injuries to 5 key letterman damped the team's chances for any championships. On the other hand individual efforts by several other people brought them and the team success. In the State Meet, Rick Steblay placed 2nd in the 110 Meter High Hurdles and 1st in the Intermediate Hurdles earning him and Elk River enough points for a 5th place in the team standings. Rick broke his own Intermediate Hurdle school record and tied the 220 and High Hurdle record. The 440 Relay team of Steve Slavik, Jeff Stone, Mike Morgan and Clint Leger also broke the school record, were conference champs and placed 2nd in the Region IV meet. Mike Donahue broke the school record in the triple jump, broke the Sophomore Long Jump record and tied the High Jump record. In addition many other Elks contributed to the overall effort of the 1979 team. Again many PRs were attained to the great tradition of Elk River Track Teams continued. Although 1980 will find the Elks without 1/4 of last year's tracksters, tradition and hard work again will find the Elks striving for, and reaching many new goals.

1980 found the Elks with few in numbers and few in experience. The highlights of the year were Elks records broken and tied, and Mike Donahue's 7th place finish in the state track meet, in the long jump. Steve Rye broke the Sophomore 1 and 2 mile records, Keith Barnier the Soph. Intermediate Hurdle record, Bret Beaglund the Soph. 200 record, Jon Smith the Soph. Discus Record, Lance Haaglund the Varsity 200 record, Mike Donahue the Varsity Triple Jump record and Jeff Zarwas tying the Varsity Pole Vault record. With Colin Anderson training towards an Olympic team berth, Dave Stadden took over assistant coaching duties and did a fine job. The Elks should be returning a strong nucleus for the 1981 season. With a little more depth, the Elks could be contenders in 1981.

The 1981 season found the Elks starting slow and finishing strong. At the end of the season, the Elks had placed second in the Central Lakes, 2nd in the Chieftan Invitational, 4th in the Region and had 5 people in 3 events at the state track meet. They were Mike Donahue in the Long Jump, Keith Barnier in the Intermediate Hurdles, and the 440 Relay team of Mike Donahue, Ray Schreckengraust, Bret Beaglund and Lance Haaglund. The 1981 Elks broke 4 varsity records and tied one; and broke 2 Sophomore records. Mike Donahue broke the Long Jump and Triple Jump Varsity records, Bret Beaglund the Varsity 200 record, the 400 and 800 Relay teams both broke Varsity records and Pat Carr broke the Soph. 400 record while Ray Schreckengraust broke the Soph. Long jump record. With the loss of only 4 seniors the Elks are looking forward to 1982.

5. COACHES RESERVE THE RIGHT TO WITHHOLD LETTERS FROM ATHLETES WHO DISPLAY CONDUCT AND/OR ATTITUDES DETRIMENTAL TO THE TRACK TEAM., REGARDLESS OF THE NUMBER OF POINTS EARNED DURING THE SEASON.
6. COACHES MAY ADJUST LETTER REQUIREMENTS DUE TO INJURY, ILLNESS OR UNFORSEEN CIRCUMSTANCES.
